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## Captain Noah and his Floating 800

Come and sing this jazzy, humorous musical setting of the story of Noah's Ark, one of the jolliest of the light-hearted cantatas, with music by Joseph Horovitz and words by Michael Flanders. Adult singers are welcome to bring their children (age eight and older) to join in with them. No musical qualifications or experience are needed. You just enjoy the opportunity to have fun singing in a large group.

If you want to hear what Horovitz's work sounds like, you can find Captain Noah on YouTube. The version by Roeland van der Hoorn is probably the best to listen to, but some of the items are a little too quick.

There is scope for a percussion part and we do have a resident drum kit. Volunteers welcome.

The performance is intended to take place at 7pm on Saturday 22 June at St Mary Magdalene Church, Albrighton, if enough singers volunteer to take part.
