The cost of a school dinner for children in Nursery and KS2 (Years 3 to 6) is \pounds 2.40 per day.

Payment for school dinners must be paid in advance using our on-line system, School Money. If you do need to pay by cash, you must send the correct amount as change will not be given, it will be credited to your child's account.
