Years 4 and 5 had a fantastic time out at the nature reserve yesterday. It is so important that we explore what the local area has to offer and we are very grateful to the volunteers from the nature reserve for making it such an excellent visit. Thank you to parents and grandparents who accompanied the children on the outing, which was linked with their topic, 'Traders and Raiders'. The children foraged for natural resources to make Viking clothing dyes in Science.

Our new thematic approach to the wider curriculum was also very apparent in Year 6's class assembly yesterday. The knowledge base that the children have acquired in their topic 'Blood Heart' is impressive. The assembly itself encompassed science, fitness, and Greek mythology but in class we can see how children's literacy is intrinsically linked with the topic also. Parking in School Grounds

The cost of a school dinner for children in Nursery and KS2 (Years 3 to 6) is £2.40 per day.

Payment for school dinners must be paid in advance using our on-line system, School Money. If you do need to pay by cash, you must send the correct amount as change will not be given, it will be credited to your child's account. If there are insufficient funds on your child's account, you will be asked to pay immediately or bring sandwiches into school. If you require a password reset, please contact the school office.


