Queen's Platinum Jubilee Celebration Arrangements

Thursday 26th May

On Thursday 26th May, we invite you to join us at school in celebrating the Queen's Platinum Jubilee at a lunchtime picnic followed by a Summer Fayre.

Our picnic will be held on the school field from 12:00- 1.00pm where the children's picnic lunch can either be ordered from the school kitchen or can be brought in from home. Please bring along your picnic blankets or chairs.

We ask parents of Reception, Year 1 & 2, Year 5 & 6 to collect children from the classroom door at 12:00 to sign them out for the lunchtime to have their picnic with you. Year 3 and 4 parents will need to collect their children from the main entrance. Children whose family members are unable to join us will enjoy the picnic and fayre while remaining with their class teachers until the end of the school day.

At 1pm we will officially open our Well-being Garden, so children will be collected by their teacher prior to this and taken to the garden. We kindly ask for parents to remain on the field at this point.

After the opening, children will go back to their classes to be registered and parents will be invited into the classrooms of their children to see the work they have produced while learning about the Queen and her 70 years reign. Parents will then be able to sign out their children for the afternoon. Once they are signed out, they will not need to return to the classroom, and you will be free to take them home once you've enjoyed the fayre.

The fayre will be open at 1.30pm until 3pm with refreshments, games and stalls on offer.

Non-school uniform- On the 26th we ask children come to school in red, white and blue.

Book lunch - If your child requires a school picnic lunch on the 26th May, it will need to be ordered online by Monday 23rd May.

We do hope to see as many parents, siblings and grandparents join us on the day as possible, to mark this momentous occasion in a way that is fitting.
